WH Questions

WH questions are very common in English.

WH questions ask for information. Here are the six questions and their answers:

Question	Answer	Example
What	Thing	What is your name?
When	Time	When is the party?
Who	Person	Who is your brother?
Where	Place	Where is the bank?
Why	Reason	Why do you like pizza?
How	Directions	How do you spell your name?

WH Questions Structure

WH questions in the simple present use "do" or "be". Take a look at the structure for each of these verbs.

Do

Take a look at some examples:

- Where do you work?
- When does she wake up?
- Who is your brother?

Be

WH + BE + SUBJECT ?

Here are the examples:

- Where are you from?
- Who is that man?
- When is your class?
