After dinner Sam sometimes listens to music in her bedroom and Jonathan watches TV. They go to bed at ten o'clock.

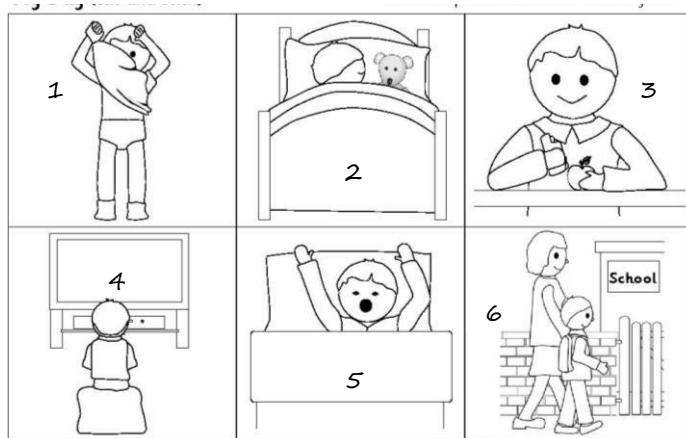
